



Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for all the support you have given me in my first week at Eversley Primary School. I would like to take the opportunity to thank you for making me feel so welcome. I have really enjoyed going on daily learning walks and seeing how hard the staff are working to ensure that your children get the best education.

It was great to meet so many of you at the coffee morning in July and listen to your positive thoughts and ideas of how we can drive the school forward to make it even better. The Senior Leadership Team and I have already put ideas into action, which we will inform you over the next few weeks.

One of the areas the school is working hard to improve is the attendance of children at Eversley Primary School. The United Nation Convention on the rights of the child entitles them to a Right to Education (Article 28). If the attendance drops below 95%, this could potentially affect any future Ofsted judgement, as well as children missing vital learning which reduces their chances of success. Please help us to continue the upward trend by ensuring your child comes to school every day and on time.

We would like to announce an exciting new system we are trialling in KS2 for lunchtimes. We are now splitting this time to give Lower Key Stage 2 and Upper Key Stage 2 their own lunchtimes. The initiative came from talking to the pupils about activities and space during lunch and how they felt it was extremely overcrowded. They now have more opportunities to take part in organised sports, more space and opportunities to play the games they enjoy with the coaches for longer periods across the week. The overwhelming responses from the pupils has been positive regarding the new changes. The times of lunch are as follows: Year 3 and 4 - 12:45 - 1:30 and Year 5 and 6 - 12:15 - 1:00. Please can you ensure that pupils do have a morning fruit that they can eat at playtimes, especially in Year 3 and 4 where their lunchtimes have moved to slightly later on than before.

Keeping up with your children's online activities is very important! Keep in mind that no app poses a danger in itself, but many do provide children with an opportunity to make the wrong choice.

Audio Manager is an app that has nothing to do with managing your children's music files or controlling the volume on their smartphone but everything to do with hiding things like photos from you. It's one of the top apps for hiding other apps. Yes, there are such things. Children can hide any app they don't want you to see. When you press and hold the Audio Manager app, a lock screen is revealed -- behind which users can hide messages, photos, videos, and other apps.

Calculator%. This time a calculator icon posing as something it isn't. Sedgrid Lewis, (online safety expert), notes that these apps look like a normal calculator app but when children push a button within the app they can hide all inappropriate pictures. "It's a key way children are hiding inappropriate pictures from their parents," said Lewis. Lewis says the best way to solve this situation is for parents to add their child to their iCloud account. That way, whenever a new app is downloaded it will automatically download to the parent's phone as well.



Vaulty will not only store photos and videos away from parental spying eyes, but it will also snap a photo of anyone who tries to access the "vault" with the wrong password. Parents who find it on their teenagers' phones can conclude just one thing: Your child is hiding things from you.



Next week I will be sending home a questionnaire, which will help inform the school of areas of strengths and areas for development. I would appreciate your thoughts, which will enable us to help develop the school further.

But after hundreds of thousands of guests passed by, the piece was returned to him stuffed with \$150 worth of additional bills. Not a single one of his original \$316 was out of place.
