Matters arising from this meeting:

Mrs Whitehouse showed the council the prizes she has ready for the winners of the 'Plastic Pollution Awareness' junk modelling competition. The children spent a long time looking at the entries to the competition and deliberating who should win from each key stage. It was decided that the KS1 winner was Esther in 1C. Her entry was a plane made from a plastic bottle and other plastic recycled materials. The plane included a simple mechanism and wheels, which enabled the plane to move! It was decided that the KS2 winner was Corinne in 5L. Corinne designed and made a landscape showing the devastating effect of plastic pollution on the environment. Both winners will receive their prize in assembly and Mrs Whitehouse will put the result and a picture of the entries in the newsletter.
