Safeguarding - Momo

Yesterday, I sent an email about an online site called 'Momo.' I had spoken to other Headteachers who had sent letters and information to parents/carers about the dangers of this site and what to do. In the afternoon, the BBC reported that there is no evidence of any threat to children from the 'Momo challenge.' I will not be doing an assembly about this, as I don't want to address it and children who don't know anything about it start to search for information. Please ensure that your child/children are safe online and know what to do, if they are concerned.

Worry Box

Today Tara and Mrs Gonzalez held an assembly about 'Worries.' It focused on worries at – school, home, health, friends and other issues. The children have been told that we have now placed a 'Worry Box' in each building beside the 'House point' displays. They can either fill in a slip with their worry at school or at home and then post them in the locked box. Each morning, Tara will empty the box and discuss with SMT what action that needs to be taken. This could involve – an assembly about the worry, circle time, meeting the child individually or PSHE work within their class. We hope that it will help reduce anxiety and help all children be happy both at school and home.

MP Visit

Our local MP Bambos Charalambous visited our school today and carried out a learning walk, which involved talking to some children in class. They discussed about what changes they would like the Government to make. Some of the children discussed making changes to the environment, including plastic and traffic pollution. I also spoke to him about how all schools are facing a budget crisis and if the Government don't make changes most schools will have a deficit budget in 3 years' time of a 1,000,00.00!

World Book Day 7th March 2019


Just a reminder that we will be celebrating World Book Day at Eversley on **Thursday 7th March**.
