### 6DS Forest School Survival

On Wednesday 19th June 6DS took part in their 'Forest School' survival session. The children split off into their groups (Fire, Water, Shelter and Food). They worked well to support each other within their teams.

**The water team** filtered and purified pond water, using a sock. They then learnt how to boil water using a 'storm kettle' and made yummy hot chocolate for everyone.

**The fire team** gathered fire wood then practised lighting cotton wool using a fire steel. The team then built a large group fire in which they toasted marshmallows. The melted marshmallows were then squashed between two chocolate biscuits, to create our dessert - s'mores.

**The food team** had planned a comprehensive survival menu. Half the group focused on chopping, peeling and cooking the vegetables for their delicious nettle soup. The rest of the group prepared a tasty rosemary bread, which was cooked on the fire.



**The shelter building group** were practising their knots and problem solving skills to assemble two different types of shelter.

To finish our session, the children competed in a tug of war competition. It was very competitive but great fun! We were so impressed with this lovely year 6 class! We look forward to Forest School with 6R next week. Don't forget your kit!
