The Food group delegated well and prepared a delicious red lentil soup, rosemary bread and chocolate covered strawberries. It was very tasty! Some children helped themselves to seconds.

The Water group filtered and purified pond water to produce hot chocolate for the group. Bilal also had great success smashing together two coconuts to crack them - fantastic problem solving skills!

Finally, the Shelter group produced two beautiful shelters, using only tarpaulin, parashord and tent pegs. This was no easy feat and children had to problem solve how they could work together to raise their tarpaulin high enough and successfully secure it.

It was a wonderful afternoon of cooperation, teamwork and perseverance. Finished with yet another tug of war contest, this time on even ground. Well done 6R!!!
