Reading comprehension	<b><u>1/2 hour per day</u></b> , work through the activities with your child.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Choose a book from home to read with your child.</li> <li>2) Highlight any unknown words, any words you cannot pronounce, and then look them up in a dictionary. Ask your child to write the word and definition if they can – create a dictionary.</li> <li>3) Choose five words most unfamiliar to you and write each of them in a sentence.</li> <li>4) Write a paragraph which you think may follow the text.</li> <li>5) Make 3 inferences about the setting, some characters or the plot.</li> <li>6) Question your child about what is happening in the text. Times Tables	30 mins daily	Practice your 2, 5 & 10 times tables. Google BBC Supermovers 2 times table, 5 times table and 10 times table. Once you have clicked on the link, join in with the activity. If you do not have internet access at home, use pen and paper to either make flash cards to practice (e.g. $2 \times 4 =$ ) or alternatively write the times tables on a piece of paper for your child to write the answers on (in order first and then mixed).
