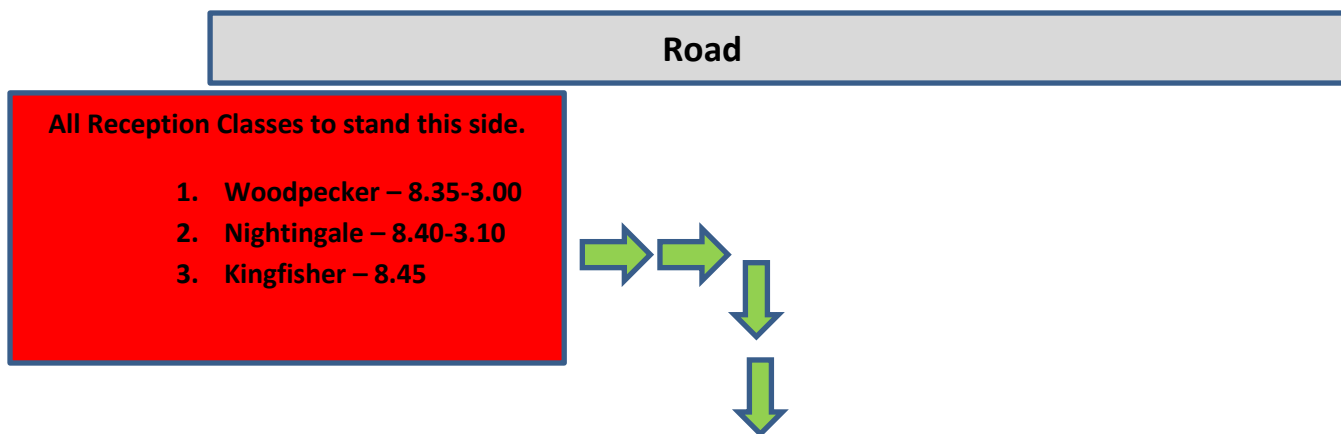

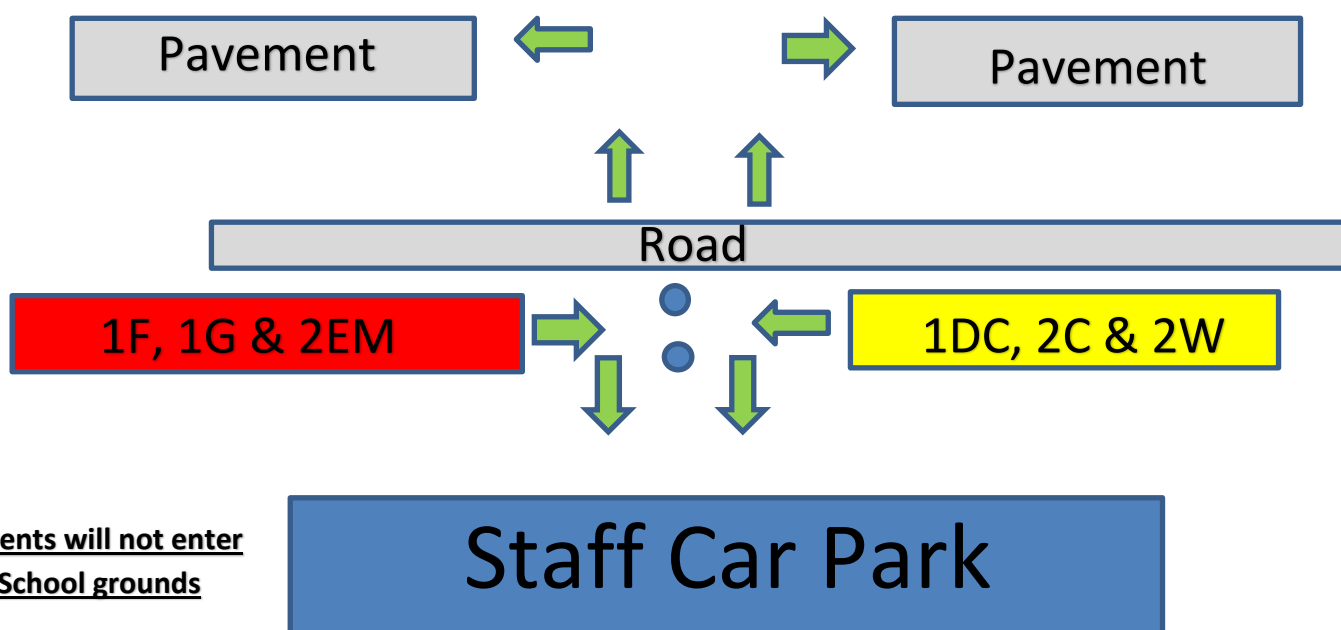
Reception Classes (EYFS/Reception Gate)

Years 3 & 4 and Sunshine Class (Main Entrance in Chaseville Park Road)

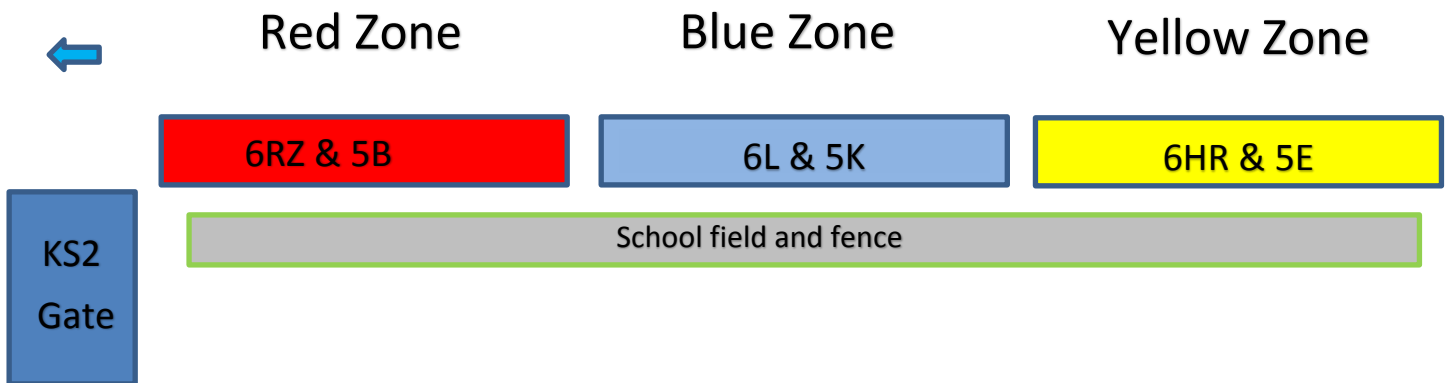
Drop off and collection points have not changed. Please check the table on the first page for times.

Years 5 & 6 Arrangements (KS2 Field (bottom of Oakwood Crescent))

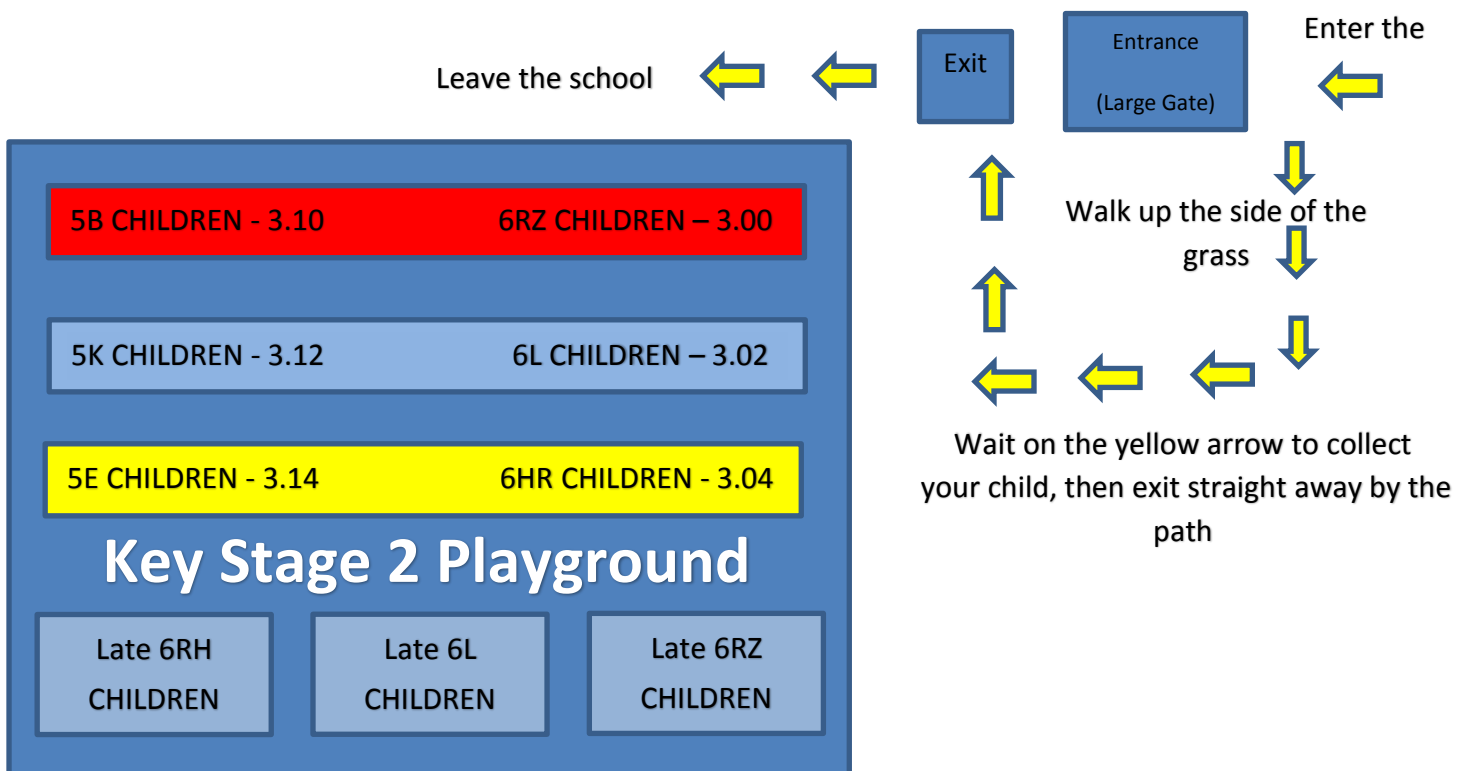
Please see the diagrams, which clearly illustrate what to do.

Wearing Face Masks

I would like to ask parents and carers if they could all wear face masks when dropping and collecting children. I cannot enforce this, but feel we all need to help prevent the increase of Covid-19 cases within our community.

Siblings

I know that we have many families who have children in different year groups. I know that some schools are allowing older children to walk across the school and collect younger children. We will not be doing this, as this would mean crossing bubbles and if a child or adult test positive for Covid-19, then more bubbles would need to be closed.

Please don't worry if you have pick-ups or drop-offs at the same time or a little later. All adults will keep hold of your child and ensure they are kept safe.

Contact definitions:

- **Direct close contacts:** Direct face to face to face contact with a case for any length of time, including being coughed on or talked to. This will also include exposure within 1 metre for 1 minute or longer
- **Proximity contacts:** Extended close contact (within 1-2m for more than 15 minutes) with a case
- Travelled in a small vehicle with a case

Any person who tests positive will have to use track and trace and identify any person they have come into close contact with. They will then have to self-isolate according to the government guidance for 14 days.
