Happy School Bag is a multi-beneficial scheme, which allows schools/organisations to raise funds through collecting unwanted clothing. It also helps the environment by diverting textile waste from landfill sites for reuse or recycling. The more we collect, the more our school will get! We get 50p per kilo for all our unwanted items. Please re-use old plastic or black bin bags. You can bring as many as you want.

On the morning of the 26th March, EPSA representatives will be stationed at 3 points between the school gates to collect your filled Happy School Bags. If your child/children go to breakfast club, please leave your filled bags at the drop off point in the front garden of the caretaker house by the main school gate.
