EPSA Fundraising goal for Spring & Summer term 2021

Our aim, over the next two terms, is to support the school with their ICT costs which include equipment, resources and subscriptions. The pandemic has highlighted how important it is for them to upgrade and maintain their ICT in order to deliver the best education possible to our children. EPSA has planned the two Spring fundraisers to be fun and exciting for our children whilst raising much needed funds, in a COVID-19 secure way.

Sadly, since April 2020 we have been unable to raise large sums of money because of the absence of our major fundraising events; Summer Fete 2020, Christmas Fete & Grotto 2020 and unfortunately the Summer Fete for 2021 looks less likely. In response to this EPSA, with the support of the School and our Governing Body, have decided to set up a Crowd Funding page.
