Since the launch of our crowd-funding page, we have had 37 donors and raised £2705.00.

Our most recent donors were Kira, Oliver, Matthew, Isabella (year 4) and Sophia in year 1, who ran a neighbourhood second-hand children's book sale. They also sold hand-made bookmarks, homemade lemonade and brownies and raised an impressive £330.00! This money has been added to our GoFundMe page and with the addition of gift aid, the total raised increased to £412.00.

Our target is set at £30,000.00; this will help pay for new iPads (10 for each classroom), Windows 10 & hard drive upgrade, laptops for the school and subscription costs for learning packages.
