The day will run from 09:30-14:30 with an informal concert at 14:30 (families are welcome to attend the concert). The day comprises a variety of musical games, instrument-specific training sessions and orchestral and performance workshops. Sessions will be led by Robert Hodge, Conductor-in-Residence at STAHS and Regional Director of Music for the National Children's Orchestras of Great Britain. Robert will be assisted in the sessions by highly experienced, specialist music staff.

Lunch and snacks will be provided by STAHS. Note that we have a no nut policy at the school. Please ensure instruments are clearly labelled with your child's name and school.
