

Music Curriculum Map – Overview

Each unit of work contains many elements of music; singing, performing, rhythm work, listening to musical performances by professional musicians (by video clips) and by themselves, developing musical vocabulary and learning to play instruments. The music curriculum is shaped as a spiral, classes return to the same broad theme, but children develop musical skills and the work is more challenging as they become more proficient musicians.
