How is this achieved?

Each class has a weekly music lesson in the dedicated Music Room with a teacher who specialises in teaching music to Primary aged children. The Music room is resourced with many instruments which the children use each lesson. There are many termly performing projects where the whole class learn to play the recorder, and at a different time, learn to play the ukulele or work together learning a repertoire of songs for a concert. At other times, children explore music using the percussion instruments. As the children move through the school they become proficient at composing music using an Ipad.
