


These are some of the activities Ted likes to do.



Ted especially likes spending time in his lovely, cosy reading area where he can look at lots of different types of books with his friends.






Children at Eversley spend lots of time outside and do some fantastic learning in all types of weather, so it is very important that they remember to bring waterproof coats and wellies with them.


