Children will begin to learn to listen to one another and develop positive relationships.</p>

**This term we will be thinking about friendships:**

Among other things this term we will be working on our ability to share, take turns, and negotiate. To do this we will learn to play together and make friends. We will be playing games, singing and exploring in a language rich learning environment both inside and outside the classroom.

To develop our **personal, social and emotional skills** we will develop a sense of ourselves and our friends, show respect for each other and improve our social skills. We will also become more independent as individuals, accessing and using resources in our environment. We will also learn about and manage our own personal health care.

For our **Physical Development** we will be working on coordination skills, control and manipulation (fine and gross motor) both inside and outside the classroom. We will consider ways of moving under, over and through equipment taking care to stay safe. We will also explore moving in time to music.

To improve our **Communication and Language** skills we will begin to share special times with our peers and teachers. We will enjoy learning in a language rich environment. We will have fun exploring our different role play areas and discussing books and stories that we have read.

In **Literacy** we will be learning to blend orally, to ensure that we hear the sounds in short simple words. We will begin learning synthetic phonics which will be shared with our families. Books will be sent home to support the learning taking place in school as well as providing stimulating and engaging books to share with our loved ones in our homes.

In **Maths** we will be deepening our understanding of numbers to 5. We will be matching, sorting comparing and representing numbers. We will also be looking at pattern and shape. We will explore time and spatial awareness to include positional language.

To develop our **Understanding of the World** we will explore the world in which we live with a focus on seasons and change.

We will also enjoy learning about each others' different festivals and celebrations.

As **artists** we will begin to use our imagination during play. We will start to develop our thoughts, ideas and feelings through a variety of art, music, dance, role play and design technology.
