This week's role model of the week is Rose Ayling-Ellis



Rose is a British actor famous for her role in EastEnders. Most recently though, she has become best known for winning Strictly Come Dancing, something even more impressive given that Rose is deaf.

Rose's most iconic moment of her Strictly journey was when she performed a dance with her partner, Giovanni, in which they danced a section in complete silence, as a tribute to the deaf community.

Rose's appearance on the show has also prompted a huge increase in interest in deaf culture and learning British Sign Language (BSL), with the Institute of British Sign Language and other providers saying they received a rise in inquiries every time Strictly aired.

Her inspirational journey has shown that deaf people can be successful and can achieve their dreams, no matter how big, as long as they have the right support, encouragement and access to opportunity.
