To use a digital device to take a photograph	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can explain what I did to capture a digital photo I can recognise what devices can be used to take photographs I can talk about how to take a photograph

Key vocabulary

Spelling	Definition
Device	A thing made or changed for a purpose, especially a piece of mechanical or electronic equipment
Camera	A camera is an instrument used to take, or record, pictures of people and objects. Some cameras record single, still pictures called photographs .
Photograph	A picture made using a camera .
Capture	Recording a picture using a camera or other media device .
Digital image	A type of a image made from pixels . These are tiny little bits of the image put together to create the photo.

- Create a photo gallery somewhere at home of photos taken by yourself
- Spend some time looking at different photographs, discussing whether they have been edited or not and how you know
- Dig out any old cameras in the house and try and get them working!
