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## Key Knowledge

## Key vocabulary

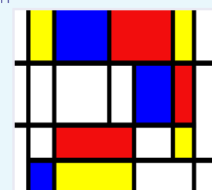
Spelling	Definition
Freehand	Done without the use of anything guiding the hand.
Tool	A tool can be found in the toolbar. There are many different tools to use, including changing the shape and lines on your drawing.
Software	The programs used by a computer.
Fill Tool	A tool that fills a space with a colour of your choice.
Pointillist Painting	A picture or painting created by drawing tiny dots of pure colour, which become blended by the viewers eye.

- Paint or draw a picture at home and try and copy this onto a computer, using drawing software.
