## Key vocabulary

Spelling	Definition
Pulse	<b>Pulse</b> is a steady beat, like a ticking clock or your heartbeat.
Rhythm	<b>Rhythm</b> is a pattern of long and short sounds.
Pitch	The <b>pitch</b> of a sound is how high or low the sound is. A high sound has a high <b>pitch</b> and a low sound has a low <b>pitch</b> .
Tempo	The word <b>tempo</b> means 'rate or speed'; in other words, it's how fast or slow something is happening.
