We used chalk, pastels and crayons to complete our pictures.

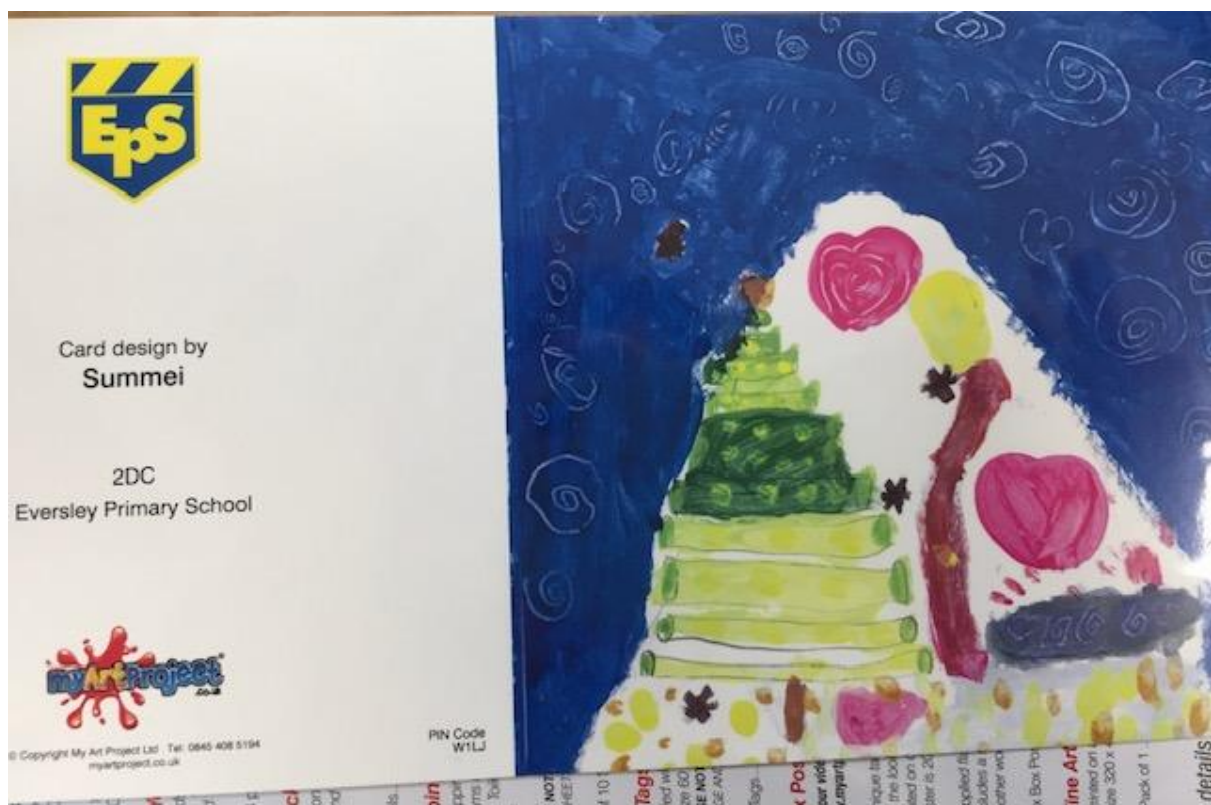


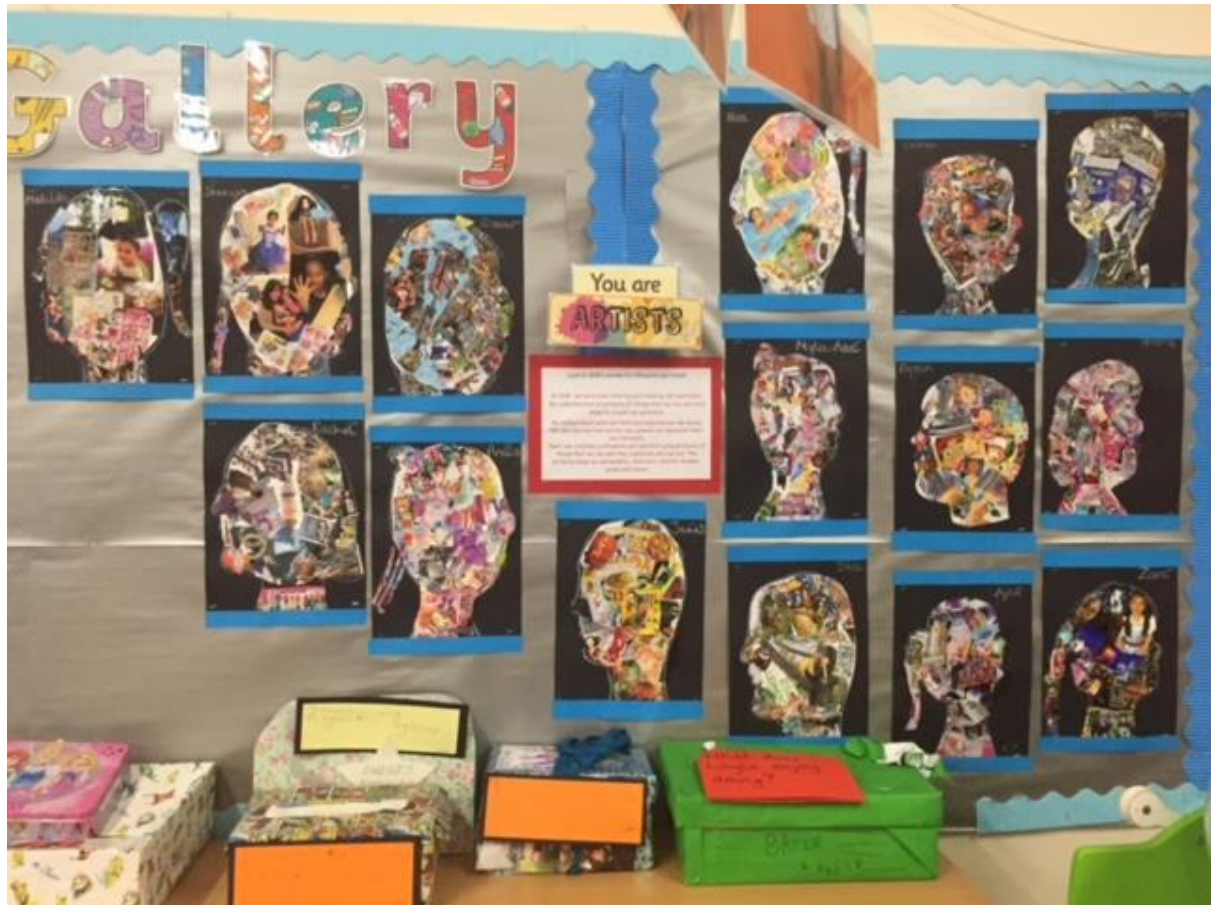

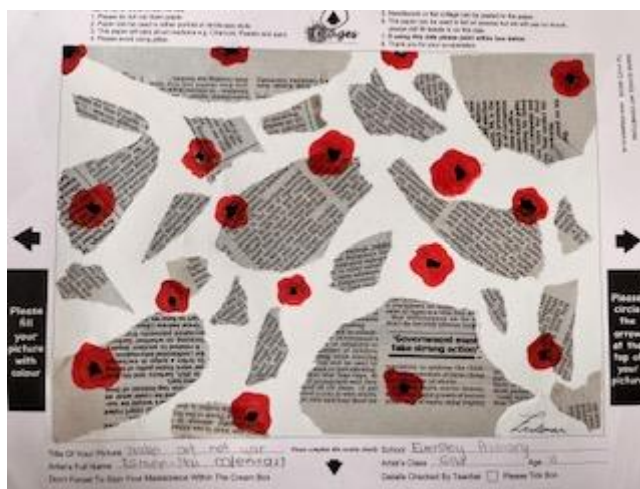
In our Art Gallery, we have displayed and made various projects for our students.

 made.

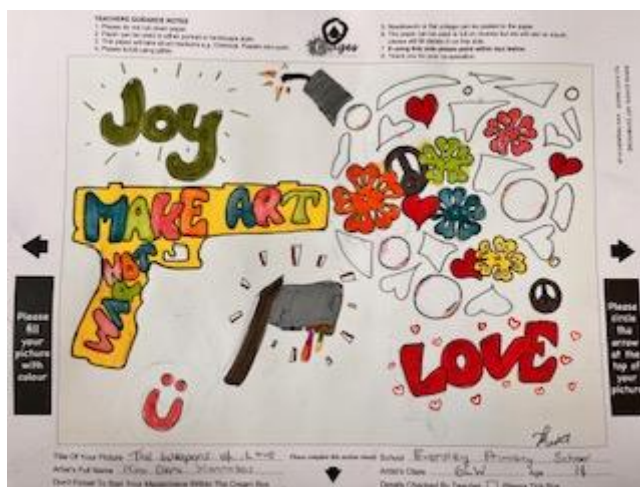
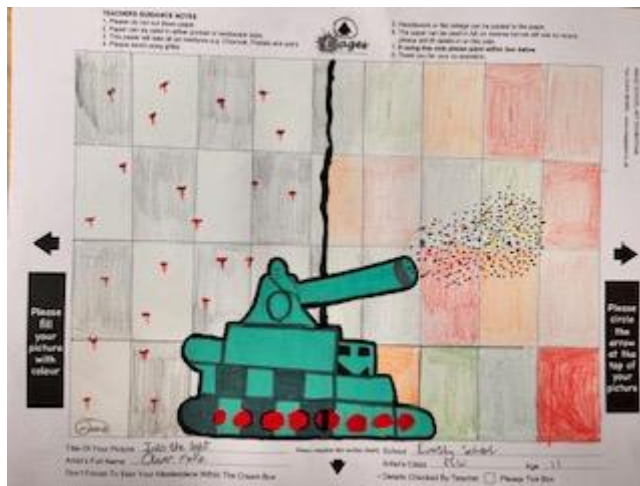
















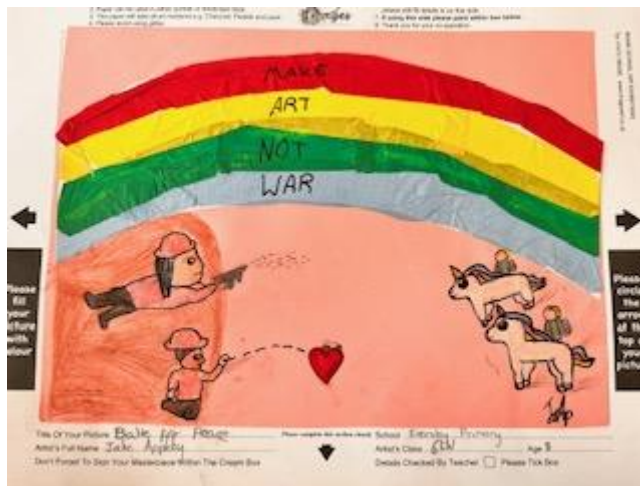
