Supported internships Mencap – info sessions





Mencap are hosting information sessions in September regarding their supported internship programme, which currently has places available in London for this academic year.

Supported internships are open to young people aged 16-24 with an EHCP. They may be the ideal programme for young people not currently in employment, education or training who want to work.

Mencap's supported internships are delivered to small groups and provide access to work experience opportunities with a wide range of employers across lots of different sectors, supporting people to find paid work at the end of the programme. For more information, see Mencap's website <u>here</u>

Webinar – what to do if your child cannot access their free school meals

Contact (the Charity for Families with Disabled Children, is hosting a free online Zoom meeting with human rights lawyer Alex Rook and Barrister Steve Broach. This is part of their <u>campaign aimed at stopping disabled children from</u> <u>missing out on free school meals</u>. A third of eligible disabled children are currently missing out on their free school meal (e.g. because of dietary requirements or sensory processing difficulties or because they are out of school due to longterm illness or because they are waiting for a suitable place).

The webinar will explore how you can ask your school or college to make a reasonable adjustment such as providing food vouchers.
