Parent Workshops and Learning Cafes



It has been great to see so many parents and carers attending the different workshops, meetings and learning cafes this week.

This week, Mrs Ratip has been delivering fantastic 'Maths Mastery Workshops' for parents in Reception, Years 1 & 2. Parents have had the opportunity to come in and work alongside their child developing an understanding of how maths is taught. The feedback has been really positive and parents feel they now have the skills needed to support their child/children at home.

Over the last three weeks Miss Goddard and the Reception team have been holding 'Phonics Cafes' for Reception parents. It has been a great opportunity to see how phonics is taught and then how it is developed throughout the day by having different workstations set up within the classrooms. The feedback again has been really positive from parents

who attended. They really enjoyed the range of activities the reception team had set up for them to explore with their child/children.

Over the last two weeks Mrs Georgiou and Mrs Kirkpatrick have held two meetings to share the new behaviour policy, which is now being embedded across the school. The parents/carers developed a better understanding of how behaviour is managed in a trauma informed way.
