Detail	Extra detail, decoration or items that add interest
Sculpture	Art in three dimensions; something you can walk all around to look at; pick up or hold
Three dimensional (2D)	A solid shape; art that isn't flat on paper







Tree of Life

Many cultures have stories about a tree of life. The tree often represents all of nature



