### Key Vocabulary

Sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures
Sculpture	Three dimensional artwork
Structure	Parts arranged in a particular way e.g. a cardboard model


### Key Knowledge

**Colour:** Using light and dark colours next to each other creates contrast

**Form:** Three dimensional forms are either organic (natural) or geometric (mathematical shapes, like a cube)  
Organic forms can be abstract

**Shape:** Negative shapes show the space around and between objects.  
Artists can focus on shapes when making abstract art.
